What to Bring What Not to Bring

PLEASE NOTE: Some of our policies have changed!

**ALL ITEMS BROUGHT TO CAMP MUST BE
NAME-TAPED OR OTHERWISE LABELED!**

Athletic Equipment Storage: All campers must bring two large mesh laundry bags. These can be found at linen stores such as Bed, Bath and Beyond.



Bedding: Bedding should include two blankets and a comforter. Top sheets are required for campers' beds. Sleeping bags are required for outdoor activities; they are not permitted in the bunk. Do not send decorative carpets or rugs. They can't be sent to the laundry and are "dust magnets". Please limit the number of pillows and stuffed animals for the bed.

Crop Tops: We understand trends of today but want remind you of our down to earth philosophy. We ask campers to keep their stomachs covered at camp and that tops must reach their shorts or pants.

Dress Clothes: One nice outfit (skirt/dress for girls; khakis/slacks for boys) for our banquet, which may be brought to camp on Visiting Day. Please adhere to the request above when packing for this event.

Swimsuits: One piece bathing suits are required with NO cut-outs. NO bikinis or tankinis.

Boys' Hockey Equipment: Rollerblades, helmet, gloves and kneepads should be kept in a separate equipment bag, which will be stored in the hockey shed.

Girls' and Boys' Mouthguards: All girls and boys are required to bring mouthguards for lacrosse.

Dress-Up Clothes: We encourage our campers to bring fun dress-up clothes. Silly wigs, Western wear, large sunglasses, and plastic beaded necklaces are always put to good use during our special events, however, these items

MUST fit in the Underbed Box. (SEE NEXT PAGE). If they do not fit in the Underbed Box they will be put away in the trunk in the attic. Also, please pack a minimum of three plain white t-shirts. We also suggest that you pack a Sharpie marker for our farewell t-shirt signing party.

Chairs: Many campers bring a camp chair for outdoor activities such as campfires. Bungee chairs (except for upper senior girls), bagged metal folding chairs, hammocks, and inflatable blow-up chairs are not permitted in the bunks.



Toiletries: Camp is seven weeks long and will require an ample supply of toiletries. However, it is not necessary to send an abundance of these items. We do not ship them home at the end of the summer. While we donate all unused items to men's and women's shelters, we would like you to think about your child's personal needs before packing. For example, there is no reason to send five bottles of shampoo and conditioner. Should your child run out of these items, we will contact you to send an additional supply. **We recommend sending liquid hand soap.**

Sunscreen: We strongly recommend that you send your camper with Blue Lizard Australian Sunscreen. This sunscreen contains zinc oxide and is very effective for active kids.

Flushable Wipes: Please do not send any wipes. These wipes are not flushable in our sewage plant system.

Towels: Towels will be provided by Camp Starlight for the waterfront and showering. You can still send washcloths and hand towels.

Cubbies: All campers are provided with a cubby with three shelves in the living area of the bunk. We suggest that you send “Cubby Cubes” to hold pajamas, socks and underwear. Cubby cube size is 10x10x10. Alternatively, you may send three plastic shoebox-sized containers (13” x 7½” x 4½”) without covers.

The only items permitted on top of the cubbies are flashlights, battery fans and clocks. Please make sure that all other miscellaneous items fit in the bed storage box.



Under-the-Bed Storage: Over the years we have seen a tremendous increase in campers bringing what we call “Bunk Junk.” These items include cards, games, stationary, books, Olympic gear, stickers, duct tape, etc. While we encourage our campers to bring such items, the excess amount brought by each child has made it difficult for bunks to remain organized and clean. In order to provide a uniform solution to the issue, we are permitting each camper to bring an under-the-bed storage container to store all such items.

The recommended “Underbed Box” can be found at The Container Store or containerstore.com and is priced under \$11.00. The item is called “Our Underbed Box” (Item Number 10008763). The size of the container is 27 1/8” L x 16” W x 6” H. If you chose to substitute another container, it cannot exceed the size listed above. All Bunk Junk should be packed in the container and placed in the luggage shipped to camp. If an item does not fit in the container, **DO NOT SEND IT!** Campers are not permitted to have any other other cardboard or plastic wardrobe boxes, storage drawers, lock boxes, mini trunks or chests, shoebags, or other hanging items.

Items on the Bed: We strongly suggest that you send only a few items that rest on top of the bed. More than one decorative pillow and a few stuffed animals becomes difficult for campers to manage and often results in these items just sitting on the floor.

Items on the Wall: Keep in mind that there is limited wall space for each camper. All decals must be removable.

Toys/Games: Please limit the amount of toys and games. There are plenty of things to do in the bunk; one or two items to keep your child busy during quiet time is all they need.



PLEASE NOTE: We will provide a hoop basketball game. Do not send individual basketball hoops. Mini hockey games are not permitted in the bunk.



Stack the Caps: We encourage you and your camper to participate in “Stack the Caps”, our charity benefiting children with cancer. If you would like your camper to participate, please send one or more new/unused baseball caps for donation. Please place the caps in a plastic bag marked “Stack the Caps” and we will give it to your camper for participation in the event.
