REQUIRED IF REGISTERED FOR RIDING

- □ 1 Stadium Chair (Crazy Creek or other)

- Glasses and a backup pair (If worn)

- 2nd Session Only 7 different small gifts for Secret Snowflake and 1 large gift (these can be made at camp or bought for a few dollars each and the final gift should be worth no more than \$10. All is given to the same person)

OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Mouth Guard for Field Hockey and Lacrosse (If your camper intends top play)
- □ 1 Eye Guard for Lacrosse (If your camper intends to play)
- □ 1 Shin Guards for Soccer and Field Hockey (If your camper intends to play)
- D Plastic Storage Bin for under the bed (Max size 12" H x 30" W x 30" L)

CLOTHING RESTRICTIONS

We ask that all staff and campers wear articles of clothing that allow them to be active. Sweatshirts and t-shirts with ANY logo on them other than "Camp Wa-Klo" logos are not allowed on uniform days. "Civvies Day" or the non-uniform day is the only day that any appropriate clothing and a two piece swimsuit can be worn.

CIVVIES

Your camper will have the opportunity to wear non-uniform clothing once per week (generally on Saturdays) and during special events. Two or three outfits will be enough for the session. Also, there will be different events, such as skit night, where a few costume pieces might be needed. So a funky scarf, head piece, wild skirt, etc. might be fun to bring. As indicated on the "recommend packing list", a nice outfit may be worn on "formal night" during both sessions, and a solid white dress or outfit can be worn during Final Banquet during the 2nd session.

MONEY AT CAMP

Money isn't needed at camp. Campers are not able to use cash to purchase items at Sugar Shack. Campers may opt to bring a little pocket money needed for special events such as age group-specific outings.
