### Required Uniform Gear

- Updated 1/18/21
- 1 CLC Sweatshirt
  - 3 White CLC Traditional Tees  
Varsity/JC Campers replace with Varsity/JC Tees
  - 3 Green CLC Traditional Tees  
Varsity/JC Campers replace with Varsity/JC Tees
  - 1 **OPTIONAL** Athletic Reversible Jersey or Reversible Mesh Tank
- NOTE: This can replace 1 White and 1 Green Tee listed above (you will then need only 4 total White/Green Traditional Tees instead of 6)
- 1 Pair White Shorts (choices avail./logo optional)
  - 1 Pair Green Shorts (choices avail./logo optional)

- 1-2 Sets of Warm Sleepwear

- 1 Pair Hiking Shoes (sneaker-style or rugged)

- 1 Standard Pillow
- 1 Shower Organizer
- 1 Laundry Bag
- 1 End-of-Bed Shoe Organizer (Velcro straps)
- 1 Mesh Sock/Delicates Bag
- 1 Reusable Drinking Cup
- Hairbrush/Comb
- Soap/Body Wash
- Shampoo + Conditioner
- Deodorant
- Toothbrush + Toothpaste
- Shower Shoes/Flip-Flops (for bunk only)

### Additional Gear

- 1 Sleeping Bag (all campers)
- 1 Flashlight
- 2 Water Bottles
- Insect Repellent
- Stationery + Stamps
- Pre-Addressed Envelopes/Labels + Pens/Pencils
- Books, Playing Cards & Non-Electronic Games
- Battery-Powered Reading Light
- Drawstring Bag or Light Backpack
- Battery-Powered Fan
- Extra Batteries (for above items)
- Extra Pair of Eyeglasses + Sport Straps (suggested for campers with glasses)
- Bedside Organizer (optional)
- MP3 Music Player (optional, no video/Wi-Fi)
- Storage Container for Stuff (optional, 14.5" x 8.25" size maximum)
- Clipboard with Holder/Case (optional)
- 1 Stuffed Animal (optional)

### Specialty Gear

- 1-2 Mouth Guards (required for boys, required for girls who intend to play lacrosse)

The following items are required/optional (as noted) for the activities in **BOLD**

- Cleats for **Baseball/Softball/Soccer**
- Shin Guards for **Soccer**
- 2 Pairs of Socks for **Soccer**
- Tennis Racquet**
- Baseball/Softball Glove**
- Baseball/Softball Bat** (optional)
- Hockey Stick/Equipment** (optional, all equipment other than stick must come in hockey bag)
- Gymnastics Leotard** (optional)
- Lacrosse Stick** (optional)
- Roller Blades + Blade Bag** (optional)
- Golf Clubs** (optional)
- Rock Climbing Shoes** (optional)
- Musical Instruments** (optional, i.e. acoustic guitar, trumpet)
- Fishing Rod** (optional)

### Packing & Shipping

- 1-2 Soft Trunks/Cargo Bags
- 1 Sport Duffel or Small Travel Bag/Backpack

### What Should Stay at Home?

- Clothing requiring special washing
- Open-Toe Shoes
- Valuable Jewelry or Personal Items
- Any device with the ability to connect to the internet (even if you've disabled Wi-Fi)
- Any type of device with a screen (camp is a screen-free environment)
- Folding Chairs
- Area Rugs/Carpet for Bunks
- "Egg Crate" Mattress Pads
- Chests of Drawers or Under-Bed Storage Bins
- **Anything that will make a camper or parent upset if it doesn't make it home. ☺**

### If it's Coming to Camp, LABEL it!

There is **NO ITEM** on this list that is fully protected against being misplaced. Camp is a big place and many campers will have similar things. **Please take the time to make sure that everything coming to camp is labeled CLEARLY with a camper's name (last name and first initial, if possible).** CLC will share labeling options prior to the summer, but a permanent/laundry-proof marker works well.
