- Tribal T-Shirts (any Green/White for returning campers, the Red one sent to first-timer campers for any new kids this summer)

- 10 Pairs of Shorts
- 2 Sweatshirts

- Books, Playing Cards & Non-Electronic Games (if your child is a "reader," send plenty to complement the lending libraries we have at camp – and remember that packages cannot be sent to camp)
- Battery-Powered Reading Light
- Drawstring Bag or Light Backpack
- Battery-Powered Fan (optional)
- Battery-Powered Clock (optional)
- Extra Batteries (for above items)
- "Tribal" Gear (for our Color War program, first-time campers will find out team at camp and we will provide a "Starter Kit")
- 1-2 Mouth Guards (campers that plan to play in Intercamp Sports should bring at least 1 to camp)
- Extra Pair of Eyeglasses + Sport Straps (suggested for campers with glasses)

If It's Coming, LABEL It!
